From the new Family Handbook: Assignments:

Students should be able to complete most of their schoolwork during the time they are at school. However, this may not always be the case, especially in the upper grades. Parents/guardians play a vital role in being aware and supportive of a student's responsibilities in completing their assignments. The following is an "in the least" policy that may vary slightly depending on the teacher in certain circumstances. Parents/guardians and students are responsible for knowing the teacher's policy concerning assignments. LATE/MISSING ASSIGNMENTS: Assignments are to be turned in when due. It should be expected that the student's grade will reflect late/missing assignments. Late/Missing assignments are to be completed and turned in within a day of the due date. (This timing may vary slightly by grade and teacher.) It will be at the teacher's discretion whether the student will need to make the assignment up during free time, recess, or other times during the school day. Late/missing assignments due to absence should be completed and turned in no later than the number of days plus one of the days absent. (For instance, if a student is absent 2 days, then they will have 3 days to complete the assignments.) Parents and students are encouraged, however, to make attempts to keep current with assignments in the event of an absence to ensure the student stays on pace with the class learning.
