<b>4/5</b>	<b>Lord's Prayer: The Fourth Petition</b>
	<p>Give us this day our daily bread.</p> <p><i>What does this mean?</i> God certainly gives daily bread to everyone without our prayers, even to all evil people, but we pray in this petition that God would lead us to realize this and to receive our daily bread with thanksgiving.</p> <p><i>What is meant by daily bread?</i> Daily bread includes everything that has to do with the support and needs of the body...</p>

	How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them!
<b>4/12</b>	<b>Lord's Prayer: The Fifth Petition</b>
	<p>And forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.</p> <p><i>What does this mean?</i> We pray in this petition that our Father in heaven would not look at our sins, or deny our prayer because of them. We are neither worthy of the things for which we pray, nor have we deserved them...</p>
<b>4/14</b>	<b>Psalm 37:7</b>
	Be still before the LORD and wait patiently for him; fret not yourself over the one who prospers in his way, over the man who carries out evil devices!
<b>4/19</b>	<b>Lord's Prayer: The Sixth Petition</b>
	<p>And lead us not into temptation.</p> <p><i>What does this mean?</i> God tempts no one. We pray in this petition that God would guard and keep us so that the devil, the world, and our sinful nature may not deceive us or mislead us into false belief, despair, and other great shame and vice...</p>
<b>4/21</b>	<b>Psalm 119:33</b>
	Teach me, O LORD, the way of your statutes; and I will keep it to the end.

<b>4/26</b>	<b>Lord's Prayer: The Seventh Petition</b>
	<p>But deliver us from evil.</p> <p><i>What does this mean?</i> We pray in this petition, in summary, that our Father in heaven would rescue us from every evil of body and soul, possessions and reputation, and finally, when our last hour comes, give us a blessed end, and graciously take us from this valley of sorrow to Himself in heaven.</p>
<b>4/28</b>	<b>Psalm 118:25</b>
	Save us, we pray, O LORD! O LORD, we pray, give us success!
<b>5/3</b>	<b>Lord's Prayer: Conclusion</b>
	<p>For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.</p> <p><i>What does this mean?</i> This means that I should be certain that these petitions are pleasing to our Father in heaven, and are heard by Him; for He Himself has commanded us to pray in this way and has promised to hear us. Amen, amen means "yes, yes, it shall be so."</p>
<b>5/5</b>	<b>Hebrews 13:6</b>
	So we can confidently say, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?"
<b>5/10</b>	<b>The Sacrament of Baptism: What is Baptism?</b>
	Baptism is not just plain water, but it is the water included in God's command and combined with God's word.
<b>5/12</b>	<b>Luke 4:8</b>
	And Jesus answered him, "It is written, "'You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve.'"
