This Sunday at the 10:30 service these young men and women will be confirmed. We ask for God's continued guidance and blessing for them as they take this important step.

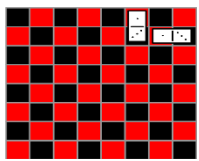
